

GAME USED BATS

1. **Luis Aguayo** 1983-1988 Worth W226
This bat shows moderate use and is cracked. It has a taped handle and has “16” written on the knob end.
2. **Ruben Amaro, Jr.** 1992-1993 LS S329
This bat shows moderate use and has some dead wood and a small piece missing from the back of the barrel. “33” is written on the knob and barrel ends. From his days with the Phillies.
3. **Larry Anderson** 1991-1994 LS M110
This bat shows moderate to heavy use and is cracked. “47” is written on the knob and barrel ends. There are specific ball ink transfers evident. The bat is autographed and is from his days with the Phillies.
4. **Kim Batiste** 1991-1994 LS C243
This bat shows heavy use and is cracked. It has a taped handle and is from his days with the Phillies.
5. **Aaron Boone** 2000 Adirondack 182B
This bat shows moderate to heavy use and has a taped handle. It has “17” written on both the knob and barrel ends.
5. **Bob Boone** 1980 Adirondack 407A
This black bat is from the championship year and shows heavy use and has a hairline crack. It has some dead wood and a piece missing on the back of the barrel. It is autographed and Boone added “1980 World Series Champs”.
7. **Brett Boone** 1999 Adirondack 460B **World Series Bat**
This bat shows moderate use and is cracked. It has a taped handle and has “24” written on both ends. It has WS 99 stamped on the knob underneath the model number.
8. **Larry Bowa** 1977-1979 H&B S222
This bat shows moderate use, is cracked, and has some dead wood. It is autographed and is from his days with the Phillies.
9. **Rico Brogna** Mizuno
This bat shows moderate use and is cracked. It has a taped handle and has some dead wood. Comes with a LOA from John Taube.
10. **Pat Burrell** 1999-2001 LS I13
This bat shows moderate use and the numbers on the knob and barrel end have been blocked out. The bat is autographed.

11. **Marty Bystrom** 1983-1985 LS
This brown bat shows heavy use and has slight dead wood on the back of the barrel. "50" is written on the knob. It is autographed and Bystrom added "5 & 0" commemorating his record in the 1980 season.
12. **Don Carman** 1986 LS U1
This bat shows heavy use and is cracked. It has "42" written on the knob and there are specific ball ink transfers evident. It is autographed.
13. **Steve Carlton** 1986 Adirondack 434B
This bat shows moderate to heavy use and has "32" written on the knob. 434B 143 6 stamped on the knob. The bat is autographed.
14. **Wes Chamberlain** 1991-1994 LS H238
This black bat shows moderate use and is slightly cracked. It has "44" written on the knob and barrel ends. The bat is autographed. From his days with the Phillies.
15. **Larry Christenson** 1977-1979 H&B P89
This bat shows light use and has "38" written on the knob. It is autographed and Larry added "1980 WS".
16. **Clearwater Phillies Team Bat** 1983-1985 LS S228
This bat shows heavy use and comes with a LOA from Blue Chip Sports.
17. **Omar Daal** 1999-2001 LS C243
This reddish brown bat shows light to moderate use and is cracked. It has "37" written on both the knob and barrel ends.
18. **Darren Daulton** 1991-1994 LS C243
This brown bat shows heavy use and has a hairline crack and slight dead wood.
19. **Ivan DeJesus** 1984 LS K55
This bat shows moderate use and is cracked.
20. **Bob Dernier** 1980-1983 LS M253
This bat shows moderate use and a very slight crack. It has a taped handle. "21" then "22" written on knob. Possibly also used by Greg Gross.
21. **Bo Diaz** 1984 Adirondack 381A
This bat shows moderate use and is cracked. The handle is taped and 6 is written on the barrel end.
22. **Mariano Duncan** 1991-1994 LS R205

- This two-toned bat shows moderate to heavy use. The handle has criss cross tape and “7” is written on the knob.
23. **Lenny Dykstra** 1991-1994 LS B267
This two-toned bat shows moderate use and has “4” written on the knob and barrel ends. It is autographed “Lenny Dykstra 1993 #4”.
 24. **Jim Eisenreich** 1991-1994 LS R205
This bat shows moderate to heavy use and has a hairline crack and slight dead wood. “8” is written on both the knob and barrel end.
 25. **Nino Espinosa** 1979 LS R199
This bat shows moderate use and is cracked. “35” is written on the knob.
 26. **Jim Fregosi** 1977-1979 LS M159
This bat shows moderate use and is cracked.
 27. **Kiko Garcia** 1971-1979 Adirondack 155B.
This bat shows light use and has “3” written on the knob.
 28. **Jeremy Giabmi** 1999-2001 LS B345
This bat shows moderate to heavy use and has “7” written on the knob. The bat is autographed.
 29. **Doug Glanville** 1999-2001 LS R219
This two-toned bat shows moderate use and is cracked. It has “6” written on both the knob and barrel ends.
 30. **Tyler Green** 1991-1997 LS B267
This bat shows moderate use and has “28” written on both the knob and barrel ends.
 31. **Tommy Green** 1991-1994 LS C271
This bat shows moderate use and has a taped handle. “49” has been written on the knob. The bat is autographed.
 32. **Greg Gross** 1980-1983 LS P72
This bat shows moderate use and is cracked. “21” is written on the knob. The bat is autographed.
 33. **Von Hayes** 1984 LS P72
This bat shows moderate use and has a slight crack. “9” is written on the knob. The bat is autographed.
 34. **Dave Hollins** 1991-1994 LS R161

- This bat shows heavy use and is cracked. The handle is taped and “15” is written on the knob and barrel ends. The bat is autographed and it comes with a LOA from Blue Chip Sports.
35. **Pete Incavaglia** 1993 Adirondack 225A
This bat shows moderate use and is cracked. “22” is written on both the knob and barrel ends. Specific ink transfers from MLB balls are evident. The bat is autographed and comes with a LOA from Blue Chip Sports.
 36. **Danny Jaskson** 1991-1994 LS R205
This bat shows heavy use and is cracked. “27” is written on the knob and barrel ends and specific ink transfers from MLB balls are evident.
 37. **Greg Jefferies** 1995-1998 Young Bat Co. GJ J727
This black bat shows light use and is cracked.
 38. **Steve Jeltz** 1988-1989 Worth WC115
This bat shows moderate use and has a slight crack and a taped handle.
 39. **Jay Johnstone** 1976 **Bicentennial** H&B P89
This bat shows light to moderate use and has “21” written on the knob. The bat is autographed and comes with a LOA from Greg Weachter.
 40. **Kevin Jordan** 1999-2001 LS P72
This bat shows heavy use and has a slight crack. “23” is written on the knob. Bat comes with a LOA from California Sports Investments.
 41. **Ricky Jordan** 1992 Adirondack 460B
This bat shows moderate use and is cracked. Specific MLB ball ink transfers evident.
 42. **John Kruk** 1991-1994 LS R161
This bat shows moderate use and has some dead wood. “29” is written on the knob and barrel ends and the bat is autographed.
 43. **Travis Lee** 1998 Glomar G341
This bat shows moderate use and is autographed.
 44. **Mike Lieberthal** 1997-1998 LS I13
This black bat shows moderate use and has slight dead wood on front of barrel. “24” is written on the knob and barrel ends.
 45. **Tony Longmire** 1991-1994 LS C243
This bat shows moderate use and has a slight crack. “27” is written on the knob, indicating a pre-rookie bat.

46. **Greg Luzinski** 1971-1979 Adirondack 300A.
This bat shows moderate use and has “19” written on the knob. The bat is autographed.
47. **Garry Maddox** 1976 **Bicentennial** H&B M247
This bat shows light to moderate use and has a small piece missing from the back of the barrel. “31” is written on the knob.
48. **Garry Maddox** 1980-1983 LS M247
This chocolate brown bat shows light to moderate use and has “31” written on the knob.
49. **Roger Mason** 1986-1989 LS C271
This bat shows moderate use and is cracked. “48” is written on the knob.
50. **Gary Matthews** 1980-1983 LS J93
This bat shows light to moderate use and has a very slight crack. “34” is written on the knob.
51. **Len Matusek** 1984 LS K75
This bat shows heavy use with a small piece missing from the back of the barrel. There is slight dead wood and has 12/17 on the barrel end of the bat.
52. **Bake McBride** 1971-1979 Adirondack 256S
This bat shows heavy use and is cracked. “21” is written on the knob and the bat is autographed.
53. **Tug McGraw** 1980-1982 Adirondack 332B.
This bat shows light use and is autographed with his full name “Frank Edwin Tug McGraw Jr.” There is no date code on the knob.
54. **Willie Montanez** 1973-1975 LS M140
This bat shows moderate use and has a piece missing from the back of the barrel and a tiny piece missing from the knob. “27” is written on the knob and the bat is autographed.
55. **Mickey Morandini** 1991-1994 LS U1
This bat shows moderate to heavy use and is autographed twice. “12” is written on both the knob and barrel ends.
56. **Keith Moreland** Cooper 256B
This bat shows moderate use and has a slight crack. “10” is written on the knob and barrel ends. The bat is autographed.
57. **Terry Mulholland** 1991-1994 LS C300

- This bat shows heavy use and is cracked. There is slight dead wood and “45” is written on both the knob and barrel ends. The bat is autographed.
58. **Todd Pratt** 1991-1994 LS C243
This reddish bat shows moderate to heavy game use and is cracked. “6” is written on the knob.
59. **Shane Rawley** 1986-1989 LS P72
This chocolate brown bat shows moderate to heavy use and has a slight crack. “28” is written on the knob.
60. **Randy Ready** 1986-1989 LS C263
This bat shows moderate use and is cracked. “5” is written on both the knob and barrel ends.
61. **Ron Reed** 1980-1983 LS P89
This bat shows moderate use and has a hairline crack and red bat rack marks. “42” is written on the knob. Bat comes with a LOA from Mike Darwish.
62. **Ben Rivera** 1991-1994 LS R161
This black bat shows light to moderate use and has “34” written on the knob. The bat is autographed.
63. **Jimmy Rollins** 1999-2001 LS T141
This bat shows light to moderate use and is cracked. It is autographed and Jimmy has added the number 6, which was his pre-rookie number. “5” is on both ends. Possible additional use by Pat Burrell?
64. **Pete Rose** 1971-1979 Adirondack 69A
This bat shows heavy use with a slight hairline crack. It is autographed “Peter Edward Rose”.
65. **Dick Ruthven** 1980-1983 LS M110
This bat shows light to moderate use and has “44” written on the knob and barrel ends.
66. **Mike Ryan** 1967-1972 H&B E32
This bat shows light to moderate use.
67. **Benito Santiago** 1996 Adirondack 460B.
This reddish brown bat shows light to moderate use and has “18” written on the knob and barrel ends. The bat is autographed.
68. **Curt Schilling** 1991-1994 LS R161

- This bat shows moderate to heavy use. There is a piece missing from the back of the barrel. The handle is taped and “38” is written on both ends. The bat is autographed.
69. **Mike Schmidt** 1988 Adirondack 154A
This bat shows moderate use and has “20” written on the knob and barrel ends. 154 A 221 8 stamped on the knob. The bat is autographed and comes with a LOA from Ed Dolan.
70. **Rick Schu** 1985 Adirondack 434B.
This bat shows moderate use and has a taped handle. “15” is written on the knob. Specific MLB ball ink transfers evident. The bat is autographed.
71. **Kevin Sevcik** 1998 Adirondack 267S
This bat shows moderate use and is cracked. “11” is written on the knob and barrel ends.
72. **Lonnie Smith** 1980-1983 LS P72
This chocolate brown bat shows light to moderate use.
73. **Kevin Stocker** 1991-1994 LS R161
This bat shows moderate to heavy use and is cracked. “19” is written on the knob and barrel ends. The bat is autographed.
74. **Amaury Telemaco** 1999-2001 LS R206
This bat shows moderate use and is cracked. There is a piece missing near the handle and “47” is written on the knob and barrel ends.
75. **Bobby Thigpen** 1991-1993 LS C271
This bat shows light to moderate use. “13” is written on the knob.
76. **Milt Thompson** 1991-1994 LS P72
This black bat shows light to moderate use. There is some dead wood on the front of the barrel and “25” is written on the knob and barrel ends. Bat comes with LOA from Blue Chip Sports.
77. **Manny Trillo** 1980-1983 LS S2
This bat shows light to moderate use and is cracked. “9” is written on the knob. Bat is autographed and comes with a LOA from Brad’s Extra Innings (BEI).
78. **Del Unser** 1967-1972 H&B O16
This bat shows moderate to heavy use and has some dead wood.
79. **Ozzie Virgil** 1984-1985 LS R43
This bat shows light to moderate use and has specific MLB ball ink transfers.

80. **George Vukovich** 1980-1982 Adirondack 154A
This bat shows light use and is cracked. It does not have a date code on the knob.
81. **John Vukovich** 1967-1972 H&B K55
This bat shows light use and has “26” written on both ends.
82. **Bob Walk** 1986-1989 LS P72
This bat shows light to moderate use and is cracked. “17” is written on the knob.
83. **David West** 1991-1994 LS C271
This bat shows moderate to heavy use and is cracked. “40” is written on both ends.
84. **Mitch Williams** 1991 Adirondack 494X
This bat shows heavy use and has a hairline crack. There are specific MLB ball ink transfers evident and “28” is written on the knob. The bat is autographed.
85. **Mike Williams** 1991-1997 LS B267
This bat shows moderate to heavy use and is cracked. “41” is written on the knob and barrel ends..
86. **Glen Wilson** 1986 Adirondack MS20
This bat shows moderate use and is cracked. “12” is written on the knob.
87. **Randy Wolf** 1999-2000 LS C271
This bat shows moderate to heavy use and is cracked. “54” is written on the knob and barrel ends.
